



TITLE: Games Management Team (Athletics, Bocce, Awards)

Our Games Management Team (GMT) is the magic behind every competition. This team makes up the athlete experience and brings joy to athletes, their families, spectators, volunteers, and more. GMT members are responsible for overseeing daily operations of their assigned functional area within the event. They may be responsible for training and leading day-of teams of volunteers. These positions are ongoing and may require team meetings leading up to competitions. The level of involvement varies by sport and event. Current open positions include GMTs for athletics (track & field), bocce, and awards for competitions.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure integrity and athlete safety during competition by enforcing rules of play
- Communicate decisions and scores with athletes, coaches, and other volunteers
- Evaluate efficiency of event to ensure quality is of the highest level

TRAINING & SUPPORT

- Encouraged to attend a SONE sport-specific training
- Locations, dates, and times will be communicated prior to the event
- Hours of competition will vary by event

QUALIFICATIONS, SKILLS & REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age 19 years old with a government issued ID (driver's license, military ID or passport)
- Must complete online volunteer application, required trainings, and background check
 - Recertification required every 3 years
- SONE sport-specific knowledge, prior coaching experience, and background working with SONE is preferred
